WHAT YOU NEED
Basic sewing tools
Colored, patterned fabrics in aqua
blue, lime green, and white
Thread in complementary colors
Embroidery floss in dark and light brown, dark and light green, light blue, dark and light coral
Embroidery needle
Embroidery hoop
$8 \times 8$-inch ( $20.3 \times 20.3 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) wood
canvas frame
Staple gun

$1 / 4$ inch ( 0.6 cm )

WHAT YOU DO
Cut different sizes of squares and rectangles from the aqua fabrics. Piece them together at random to make a square at least $10 \times 10$ inches $(25.4 \times 25.4 \mathrm{~cm})$.
) Using the project photo as a guide, cut squares and rectangles from the green fabrics, and sew them together in rows, enough to cover the hill section of the picture. Fold over $1 / 4$ inch $(0.6 \mathrm{~cm})$ of the edge of the green piece into a curve to make the hill shape and press. Use the appliqué stitch to sew the hill in place at the corner of the aqua square.
