Felt Mushrooms

Mushrooms are so cute and mysterious, they'll pop up unexpected in strange places.
No two are alike, each one has it's own personality!
You'll love stitching up a whole faery circle of mushroom friends.

What you'll need:

wool blend or heavy felt

I used: peach, cream, pink, red, plum, dark pink

embroidery floss matching the felt colors plus extras for decorating

I used: peach, cream, pink, red, plum, dark pink, dark brown

scissors

needle

stuffing

Instructions:

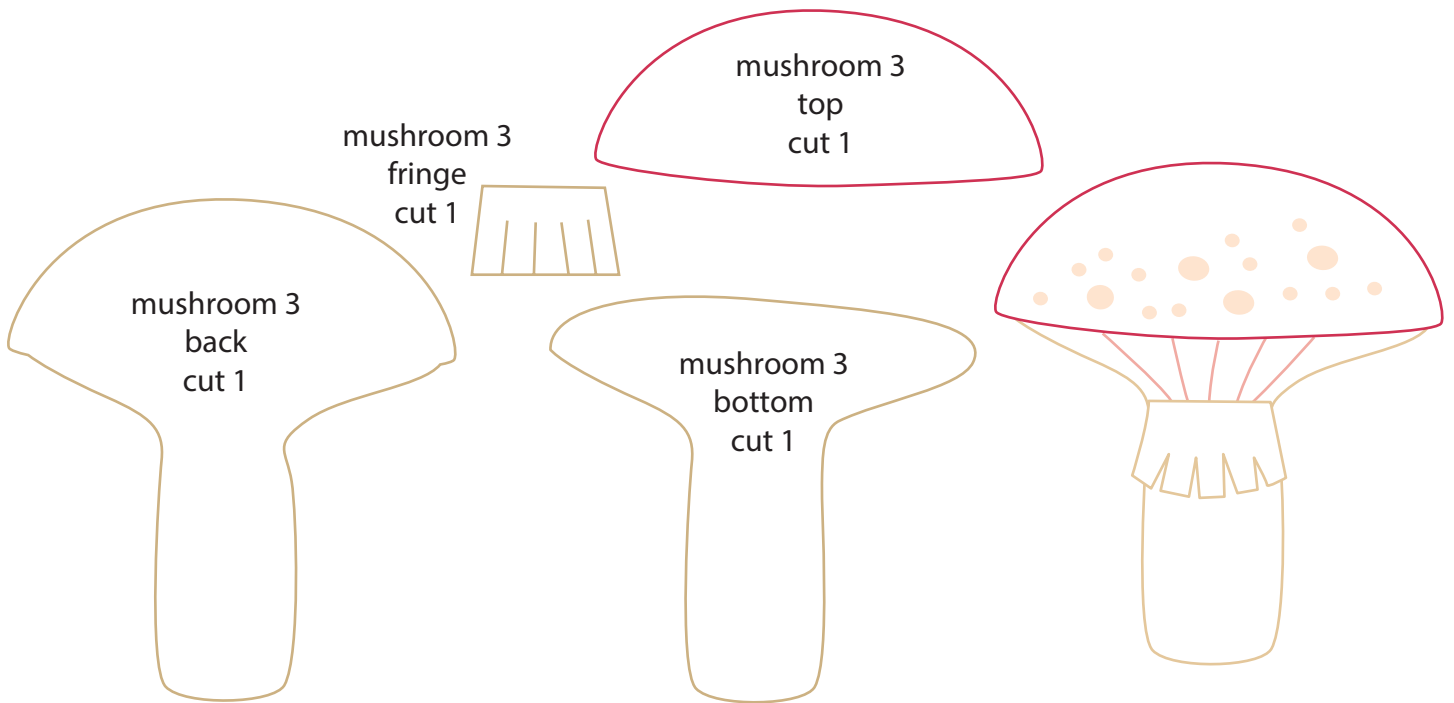
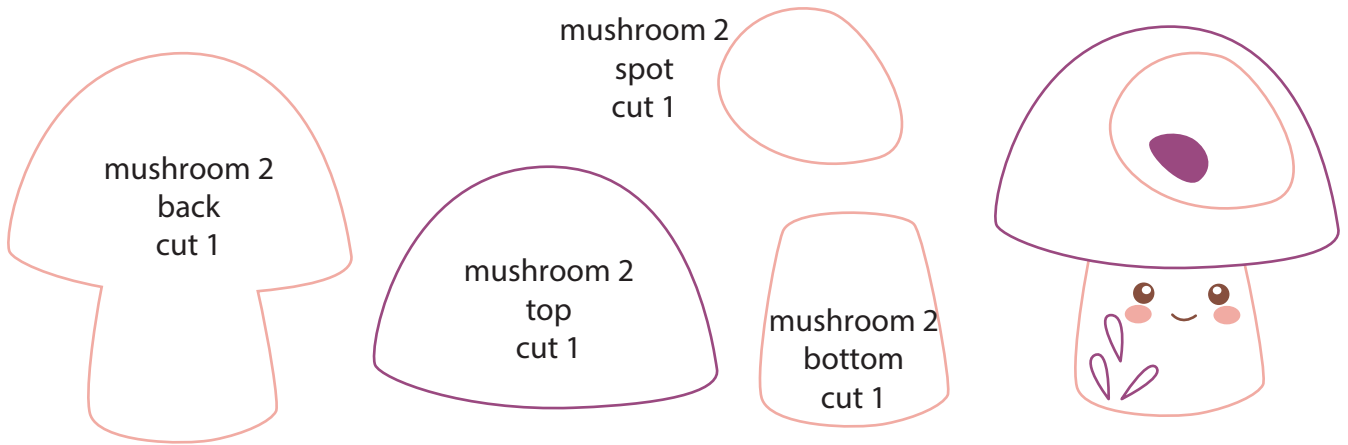
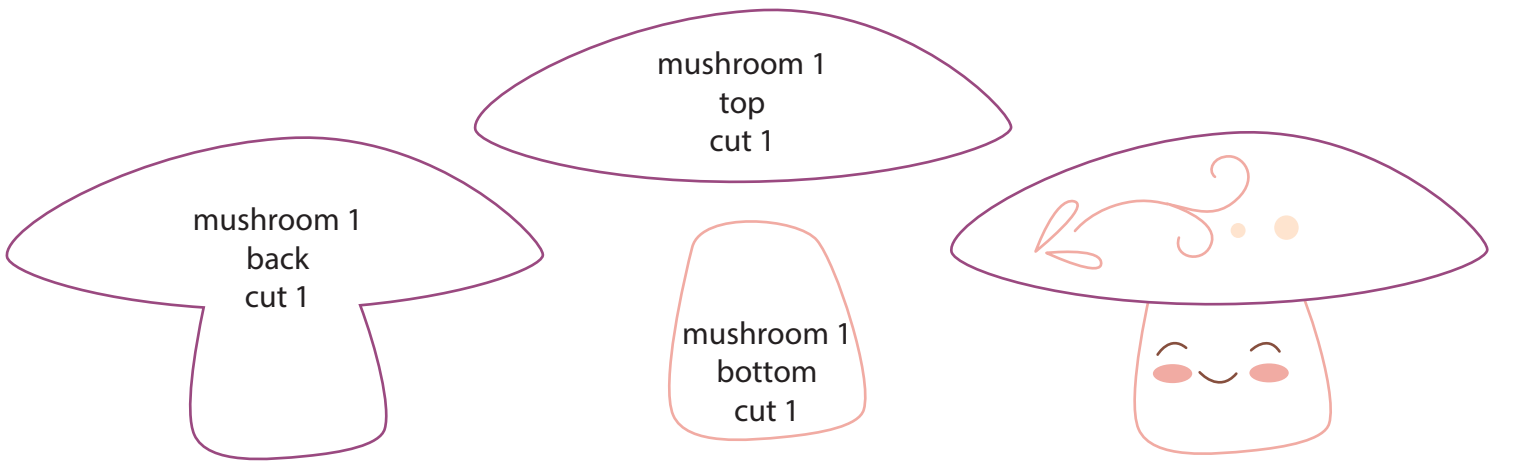
1. Print this PDF. Cut out each pattern piece. Pin or trace each pattern piece onto felt and cut out each one. You will need more than one of some shapes.
2. Using the stab stitch, below, and one thread of floss matching the felt colors, layer and stitch the pieces of each mushroom together to form the front parts. Use the back parts as guides, when the front pieces are sewn together, the finished front parts should line up with the back parts.
3. Now add decorations with hand embroidery. To transfer the embroidery patterns to felt, try this simple tissue paper method: Trace the embroidery patterns onto tissue paper, pin the tissue in place on the felt, stitch through both tissue and felt and then carefully tear away the tissue.

Or, you can always freehand the designs here, or make up your own. You'll find some easy embroidery stitch diagrams below to help you out.
4. Line up and pin each pair of mushroom parts and sew them together around the edges using the whip stitch, below. Tuck stuffing inside as you go and sew up each one.

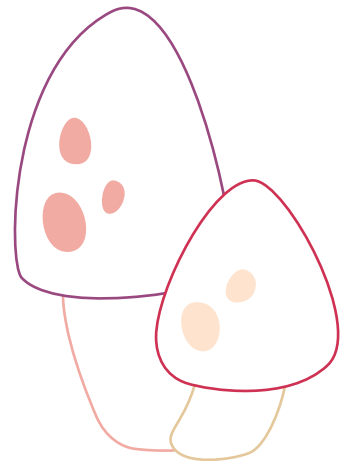
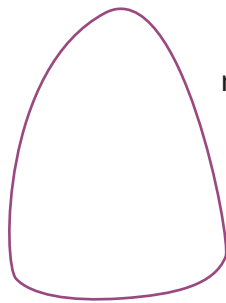
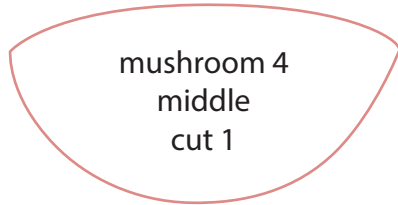
All done! Have fun with your little felt mushroom buddies,
